

Fab@School Maker Studio Valentine's Day Card Projects

Grade 4

Challenge: Make a popup heart card. Do this individually or with a partner (recommended).


1. Go to <http://fabmakerstudio.com>
2. Login with the username and password your teacher gave you. If your login doesn't work, use XXXXXXXX for your username and password until your login is fixed.
3. Click on "Ready Made-Projects." Then click the Pop-Ups tab. If you don't see any choices, wait a minute. Then, when you see choices, click on the Heart Popup and click Open.
4. Follow your trainers who will show you how to shrink the heart and the green dotted lines so that your heart will be a good size for a card. It's a little tricky, but that's OK!
5. When you have your heart the right size, save your file. Click the file folder. Click Save. Click My Online Files. Name your file and click Save.
6. Sign up to have a turn to cut your card out. While you are waiting, explore other things you can do with Fab@School Maker Studio.
7. **Everyone will not get a turn to cut out their cards during one computer session. Remember to be patient. You will get a turn another time.
8. After you cut out your card, choose a colored or white piece of paper. Fold it in half the same way your popup paper is folded. Carefully glue your pop up part on the inside of the paper.
9. Make a cover for your card. Write a short note on the inside of the card. Sign it with your **first name only** and **Goodnoe Elementary School**.
10. If you have time, make another card.

Grade 1

Challenge: Make a popup heart card. Do this individually or with a partner (recommended).


1. Go to <http://fabmakerstudio.com>
2. Login
 - a. USERNAME: XXXXX
 - b. PASSWORD: XXXXX
3. Click on "New Project."
4. Choose the paper on the right (landscape). Registration marks = NONE
5. Click the image on the left of the big, blue letter A:



6. Choose the first kind of fold (first picture)



7. Choose a heart shape. Put it on one side of the green line. Choose another heart shape. Put it on the other side of the green line. Make the hearts whatever size you want. Make the fancy by adding color or other shapes.



8. When you have your heart the way you like them, save your file. Click the file folder. Click Save. Click My Online Files. Name your file with your first and last name and click Save.
9. Sign up to have a turn to cut your card out. While you are waiting, explore other things you can do with Fab@School Maker Studio. You might not get to cut your cards until another day.**

**Everyone will not get a turn to cut out their cards during one computer session. Remember to be patient. You will get a turn another time.
