


Select Launch your Gradebook, if this is the first time you have logged in you may need to run the program, follow the onscreen prompts.



The first thing you need to do is set up categories if in fact you are going to use them.

If you plan on using total points you can skip this step.

Otherwise, Click Tools on the menu bar and scroll down to categories.



PowerTeacher comes with 4 default categories which you may find acceptable, most teachers grade students using these types of assessments. If you don't like these assessments and would like to create some of your own, click on the + at the bottom of the categories box. You will then be able to create a custom category designed specifically for your class.

Give the category a name.


Give the category an abbreviation.

You may select a color for the category but it is not required.

Make sure points possible is set to 0, (will possibly be fixed in a future version) you will be assigning points to *assignments*, no need to assign points here.

Give the category a score type, most likely points.

When you're finished, click close.



Click on the Gradebook Setup tab.

Highlight S1.


Select the radio button Term Weights

Under the Weight heading, type in these values:

F1 = 20%

Q1 = 40%

Q2 = 40%



Make sure you have the class you're setting up highlighted.

This time highlight Q1.

Select the radio button Category Weights, a small + will appear here, select the +.

Put a check in the box for the categories you would like to use for this class.

Make sure you remember to assign weight values to the category, just like you did for S1 or they won't be calculated.

Click Save and go to your next class. You must complete this process for each class you teach.
