
- 1. Students must sort out and place the flashcards into two different piles.
- 2. The two different piles will be: <u>Common Nouns</u> and <u>Proper Nouns</u>


Common Noun: A noun, such as *boat* or *man*, that represents one or all of the members of a class.


Proper Noun: A noun, such as *Titanic* or *George Washington*, belonging to the class of words used as names for unique individuals, events, or places.




- 1. Print out each flashcard in color on cardstock paper.

- 3. Keep all flashcards inside a large ziplock or folder.


























